Elections will be held for the following Offices:

Mayor	– one (1) to be elected
Councillor, Ward 1	– one (1) to be elected
Councillor, Ward 2	– one (1) to be elected
Councillor, Ward 3	– one (1) to be elected
Councillor, Ward 4	– one (1) to be elected
Trustee, Thames Valley District School Board	– two (2) to be elected
Trustee, London District Catholic School Board	– one (1) to be elected
Trustee, Conseil scolaire catholique Providence	– acclaimed
Trustee, Conseil scolaire Viamonde	– acclaimed

Voting

Election day is Monday October 24, 2022, concluding at 8:00 p.m.

The 2022 Municipal Election for the Township of Norwich will be conducted using Vote by Mail.

Electors will be able to cast their vote anytime following receipt of their voting packages, up until the close of polls 8:00 pm on Voting Day October 24th, 2022. Ballots must be received by the Township by the close of polls October 24th.

Voting Kits will be mailed to all electors on the Voters List on or about September 26th, 2022. Electors may then cast their ballots by return mail in the postage paid envelopes provided. The last day recommended for mailing back ballots with Canada Post is October 13th, 2022.

Alternatively, electors may deliver their completed voting kits (using the envelopes supplied) directly to the Township of Norwich municipal office at 285767 Airport Rd, Norwich.

Completed voting kits may be delivered to the office:

- during regular office hours (Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm) or on Voting day until 8:00 pm. or
- in the after-hours drop off slot at the municipal offices entrance at any time (24 hours, 7 days per week) until Voting Day at 8:00 pm.

If you are an eligible elector and do not receive your Voting Kit by October 5th, please contact the Township of Norwich municipal office.

Advance Voting and Proxy Voting

The Township will be using Vote by Mail for the 2022 Municipal Election. This system replaces the traditional polling place method and eliminates the need for advanced polls and proxy voting.

Who can Vote?

To vote in the municipal election, you must be a qualified elector. That means you must be:

- a resident of the Township of Norwich or a non-resident owner or tenant of lands in the Township of Norwich or the spouse of such non-resident owner or tenant;
- a Canadian citizen;
- at least 18 years of age; and
- not prohibited from voting by law

If you live in the Township of Norwich and own or rent more than one property in the Township, you must vote where you live. You can only vote once in the Township of Norwich.
